Safety Instructions for the Use of Flexible Dryers

1. Introduction

Flexible dryers are convenient and versatile devices for drying plants and other light items. To ensure their safe and effective use, the following rules regarding use, storage and maintenance should be followed.

2. General safety rules

1. Use as intended - the flexible dryer is intended only for drying light materials.
2. Avoid overloading - do not exceed the maximum permissible load specified by the manufacturer. Excessive load may damage the dryer or pose a hazard.

3. Specific rules for use

1. Stability - make sure the dryer is properly secured to the holder.
2. Weight distribution - distribute the dried items evenly to prevent the dryer from tilting or deforming.
3. Assembly and disassembly - follow the manufacturer's instructions to avoid incorrect assembly or disassembly, which could weaken the structure.
4. Do not use near open flames or radiators - the dryer may be damaged and the dried materials may catch fire.

4. Maintenance and storage

1. Cleaning - After the end of the period of use, clean the plant residues using a mild detergent and lukewarm water.
2. Drying - Make sure the dryer is completely dry before storing to prevent the growth of mold or other microorganisms.
3. Storage - Store the dryer in a dry and shaded place, away from sources of heat and direct sunlight.

5. Final remarks

Failure to follow the above rules may lead to damage to the product, a safety hazard or reduced efficiency of the dryer. If there are any doubts regarding installation or use, contact the manufacturer or distributor.
