# SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE "ODOR NEUTRALIZER" CATEGORY

## 1. Introduction

  - **Aerosol Use** – Shake aerosol containers well before use and spray from an appropriate distance.

  - **Inhalation of Vapors** – Move the affected person to fresh air and keep them calm. Call for medical assistance if needed.
  - **Ingestion** – Do not induce vomiting. Contact a doctor and provide the product label information.
