Ratchet Hanger Safety Instructions

1. Introduction

Ratchet Hangers are designed to suspend equipment and provide easy adjustment of the suspension length. This product is versatile and easy to use, however, improper use can lead to equipment damage or safety hazards. This manual provides guidelines for safe use, maintenance and storage of the hangers.

2. General safety rules

1. Use as intended - the hangers are designed to suspend equipment within the load limits specified by the manufacturer.
2. Do not exceed the maximum load - ensure that the weight of the suspended equipment does not exceed the load limit of the hanger given in the technical specification.
3. Stable mounting - ensure that the hanger is properly attached to a stable support point that can safely hold the load.
4. Do not modify the product - any design changes can weaken the mechanism and increase the risk of failure.
5. Avoid sharp edges - protect the hanger cable from contact with sharp edges that may damage it.
6. Protect from fire and high temperatures – the hangers are not resistant to open flames or extreme temperatures that can weaken the material.

3. Using the hangers

Assembly:

Properly attach the hook or other fastener to a strong support point.

Check that the hanger is securely attached before hanging the equipment.

Adjusting the length:

To shorten the line, pull on the free end, adjusting the length to your needs.

To lengthen the line, release the ratchet mechanism according to the manufacturer's instructions.

Weight distribution:

Evenly distribute the weight of the hanging equipment to avoid excessive strain on one hanger.

4. Maintenance and storage

1. Regular cleaning – remove dust, dirt and other contaminants with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using aggressive detergents.
2. Inspection before use – before each use, check that the ratchet mechanism operates smoothly and that the line or tape is not damaged.
3. Storage – Store the hangers in a dry, cool and well-ventilated place, away from moisture and direct sunlight.
4. Do not use chemicals – avoiding aggressive chemicals helps to maintain the durability of materials and mechanisms.

5. Safe handling in the event of damage

1. Discontinuation of use – if you notice any damage, such as abrasion of the cable, rust or improper operation of the latch, immediately stop using the hanger.
2. Repair or replacement – contact the manufacturer or an authorized service center to determine the possibility of repair or replacement of the product.

6. Contacting the manufacturer

If you have any questions regarding the use of the Ratchet Hanger or doubts about its technical condition, contact the manufacturer using the contact details provided on the packaging.
